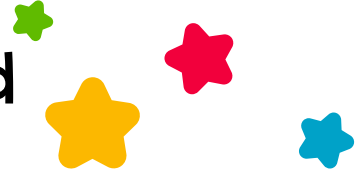

Create a nature poem using words from what you see around you.	While at the store with a parent, count money and make change for a purchase.	Identify an angle outside or in the car—is it acute, right, or obtuse?	Read a short story aloud to a friend or family member outside.
Write a sentence using a word you see on a billboard or street sign.	Make a bar graph using the leaves or flowers you find.	Pick something outside and describe it in 5 words (e.g., a tree, a car, a building).	Count the number of rocks in a specific area and estimate the total weight.
Use details to write about a place you see on your ride (a park, a school, etc.).	Draw a bar graph of car colors you see on your ride.	Estimate how long it will take to reach a destination if you left right now.	Check a speed limit sign and compare it to your speed.
Make a list of things you see out the window that start with the letter “S.”	Write a letter to your friend describing your favorite book or character.	Flip a coin 10 times and write heads and tails as fractions.	With a parent, sibling or friend, make up a story together, each person adds one sentence at a time.
